Symmetry looks to join 200-club in Group 2 Macro Meats Rookie Rebel

The Robert Britton-trained Symmetry will be looking to push his prizemoney beyond \$200,000 with victory in the Group 2 Macro Meats Rookie Rebel over 600 metres at The Meadows this Saturday night.

The son of Flying Penske and Classy Creek is fresh off an impressive 30.52 win in a Perth Cup Consolation at Cannington earlier this month, and will line up in his eighth Group final this week, including success in the Group 1 Sale Cup in December and a second-placed effort behind El Grand Senor in the Group 1 Melbourne Cup.

This year's event looks to be one of the most keenly contested since the race's inception in 2003, with less than four lengths between the personal best times of the finalists with winning form over the 600-metre journey.

Taswegian chaser Posh Di (box three) will be flying the flag for the fairer sex as the only female in the field, and her recent form – including five victories from her last eight starts – suggests that she is in with a definite winning chance.

Master trainer Graeme Bate will be looking to add the Rookie Rebel to his amazing resume of Group success with the classy Stack 'Em Flat - a winner of 20 races from just 37 starts – who will begin from box one. The Group 2 Macro Meats Rookie Rebel also highlights the success of sire Bombastic Shiraz, with five of his progeny lining up in the \$25,000-to-the-winner final.

This Saturday's meeting at The Meadows is one of the best on the greyhound-racing calendar. The night will also see the running of the Group 1 Macro Meats Temlee (525m) and the Group 2 Macro Meats Zoom Top (725m) and preliminaries of the Group 1 MTD Australian Cup. Patrons will also enjoy music from a live band, have access to free on-course TAB Big 6 vouchers and TAB Mystery Bet Combos, plus heaps of free entertainment for the kids, including the chance to win one of 25 bikes throughout the carnival.
