Can Greenough's star be too seductive in Group 2 Macro Meats Zoom Top?

Pearcedale trainer Kel Greenough will attempt to train his second Group 2 Macro Meats Zoom Top winner when So Seductive (box eight) lines up in the \$30,000-to-the-winner final over 725 metres at The Meadows this Saturday night.

Greenough trained Miss Grub to victory in 2007, and looks to have as good a chance with So Seductive, a winner of 10 races from her last 13 starts, including victory in the Group 1 Carnival Cup in November and a track record run at Sandown Park in October. The daughter of Go Wild Teddy and Smiles Are Free has won three of four her race starts over the half-mile journey at The Meadows, including a super 42.53PB last September.

Her job will not be made easy considering the quality of the field, including five-time Group winner Blue Lorian, a greyhound fresh off an outstanding victory in the Group 1 Galaxy against four rivals he faces once again on Saturday night. The son of Surf Lorian and Winsome Bluebird also has the impressive figures of four wins from four starts at The Meadows over 725 metres.

West Australian chaser Pillow Torque will make her debut at the Broadmeadows circuit after recent outstanding wins in Victoria, including a new time standard of 41.64 at Sandown Park – one of four former or current metropolitan track holders in the race. Her draw of box five should not pose too much concern, finishing in the top three in all four of her starts with the yellow rug on her back.

Evergreen performer Jarvis Bale (box two) will be lining up in his 29th Group final in his 107-start career, which is an Australian record, while young star Bobby Boucheau (box six) – trained by Greenough's daughter Angela Jackson – looks to be the dark horse of the field after recently stepping up over 700 metres in heats of the Group 1 Galaxy.

This Saturday's meeting at The Meadows is one of the best on the greyhound-racing calendar. The night will also see the running of the Group 1 Macro Meats Temlee (525m) and the Group 2 Macro Meats Rookie Rebel (600m) and preliminaries of the Group 1 MTD Australian Cup. Patrons will also enjoy music from a live band, have access to free on-course TAB Big 6 vouchers and TAB Mystery Bet Combos, plus heaps of free entertainment for the kids, including the chance to win one of 25 bikes throughout the carnival.
