Group 1 Sky Racing TOPGUN countdown: Two days to go **Enry Waltzes into TOPGUN calculations**

Gary Ennis, the trainer of star sprinter Enry Walt, has declared that his charge is fully fit and ready to tackle Australia's best greyhounds in Saturday night's Group 1 Sky Racing TOPGUN over 525 metres at The Meadows.

The son of Primo Uno and Awesome Saint – who has already tasted Group 1 success at The Meadows with a sizzling 29.84 Silver Chief win in January – had some general soreness after his fourth-placing in the Group 1 Paws Of Thunder final, but will be ready to go on Saturday.

"The dog is feeling well. He was a bit sore after his run in Sydney (on October 2), but he'll be there on the weekend giving his best," said Ennis, who believes the scratching of Queenslander Mr. Metz has changed the complexion of the black-type event.

"I was happy with Mr. Metz in the six because from what I have seen he does like to rail. Proven Jett coming in does change it up a bit, and they say Pedrosa uses lots of the track, so hopefully we can stay out of his way."

"One thing is for sure – it is such a hard race to pick the winner in. I'd say whoever can get around that first turn with minimal inference will be very hard to catch. They are all such good dogs," said Ennis.

From 17 starts off the wider boxes of five, seven and eight, Enry Walt has won on eight occasions and placed in another six attempts, including the aforementioned Silver Chief victory and a sizzling 29.48 gallop at Sandown Park on August 26.
